The objective of the RFQ is to identify a supplier who can provide UNFPA with all the above mentioned **Information and Communication Technology (ICT) products**. The selected vendor is expected to provide such products, based on specific Purchase Orders submitted to the vendor.

### III. Eligible Bidders

This Request for Quotation is open to all eligible bidders; to be considered an eligible bidder for this solicitation process you must comply with the following:

- A bidder must be a legally-constituted company that can provide the requested products and have legal capacity to enter into a contract with UNFPA to deliver in the country, or through an authorized representative to the address: United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), UN House, 9 R. Eristavi Street, Tbilisi 0179 Georgia.
- A bidder must not have a conflict of interest regarding the solicitation process or with the TORs / Technical Specifications. Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.
- At the time of Bid submission, the bidder, including any JV/Consortium members, is not under procurement prohibitions derived from the [Compendium of United Nations Security Council Sanctions Lists](#) and has not been suspended, debarred, sanctioned or otherwise identified as ineligible by any [UN Organization](#) or the [World Bank Group](#).
- Bidders must adhere to the UN Supplier Code of Conduct, which may be found by clicking on [UN Supplier Code of Conduct](#).

### IV. Content of quotations

Quotations should be submitted in a single email whenever possible, depending on file size. Quotations must contain:

- Technical proposal, in response to the requirements outlined in the specifications should comply with:
  - The bidder shall be required to quote for all items.
- Signed Declaration Form, to be submitted strictly in accordance with the document.
- Price quotation, to be submitted strictly in accordance with the price quotation form in USD (United States Dollars)

Both parts of the quotation must be signed by the company's relevant authority and submitted in PDF format.

### V. Instructions for submission

Proposals should be prepared based on the guidelines set forth in Section IV above, along with a properly filled out and signed price quotation form and are to be sent by email to the secured email address indicated below no later than : 10 November 2025, 18:00 Tbilisi, Georgia Standard Time (GMT+04:00).

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Please note the following guidelines for electronic submissions:





- The following reference must be included in the email subject line: **RFQ № UNFPA/GEO/RFQ/2025/002 – ICT Products**. Proposals that do not contain the correct email subject line may be overlooked by the procurement officer and therefore not considered.
- The total email size may not exceed **20 MB (including email body, encoded attachments and headers)**. Where the technical details are in large electronic files, it is recommended that these be sent separately before the deadline.
- Any quotation submitted will be regarded as an offer by the bidder and does not constitute or imply acceptance of the quotation by UNFPA. UNFPA is under no obligation to award a contract to any bidder as a result of this RFQ.

#### VI. Overview of Evaluation Process

Quotations will be evaluated based on the compliance with the technical specifications and the total landed cost (as per price quote).

The evaluation will be carried out in a two-step process by an ad-hoc evaluation panel. Technical proposals will be evaluated for technical compliance prior to the comparison of price quotes.

#### VII. Award

In case of a satisfactory result from the evaluation process, UNFPA shall award a **Purchase Order** to the lowest priced bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially compliant with the bidding documents.

#### VIII. Right to Vary Requirements at Time of Award

UNFPA reserves the right at the time of award of Contract to **increase or decrease, by up to 30%**, the volume of goods specified in this RFQ without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions.

#### IX. Payment Terms

UNFPA payment terms are net 30 days upon receipt of shipping documents, invoice and other documentation required by the contract.

#### X. Fraud and Corruption

UNFPA is committed to preventing, identifying, and addressing all acts of fraud against UNFPA, as well as against third parties involved in UNFPA activities. UNFPA's Policy regarding fraud and corruption is available here: [Fraud Policy](#). Submission of a proposal implies that the Bidder is aware of this policy.


